

FAQ: HOW TO EARN YOUR BADGES

What do we have to do to get our first badge?

You will need to work on a campaign which shows that you have done at least 5 actions or pieces of work, in the area of your chosen badge. If you can tick off 5 actions from the lists of suggestions for each badge on this page, then you may have earned your badge. To claim your badges, you will need to provide us with evidence during your quarterly catch-up phone calls with our Aftercare Team.

Which badge do we have to work on first?

It is completely up to you which badge you work towards first. One badge might stand out to you because it means something to you as a team or it might be an area that needs some improvement in your school.

How long does it take to earn each badge?

Each school will take a different amount of time to earn their badges. Some schools focus on 1 badge per year and others aim for 1 badge every 3 months. We recommend that your badge campaign lasts no less than 3 months.

What exactly do we need to show evidence of?

For each badge, we would like you to show how you have worked towards it in at least 5 actions or pieces of work. With each badge, at least 1 action should be directed towards engaging the Anti-Bullying Ambassador team, the school staff or the whole school. We would like to see at least 1 whole school event per badge.

How do we submit our evidence?

First of all, we will discuss your work in our quarterly catch-up phone call. Following that, we will ask you to submit the

evidence of your work: Videos, photos, survey results, blog posts, school newsletter entries, website pages, interviews, written reviews of pieces of work etc. So, remember to keep evidence of what you are working on and ensure that your team or Staff Lead gathers everything together in time for the catch-up phone call.

What will we get to show our hard work?

Once we have confirmed that your hard work has earned you a badge, we will send you your shiny new badges which you can wear on your school uniform to show that you have moved to the next level of Anti-Bullying Ambassadorship. These badges should be worn with pride, as they show that you have achieved great levels of Anti-Bullying work. We will also be happy to provide you with a graphic for your website, so you can show everyone that your school is dedicated to anti-bullying work.

What happens when we have all 4 badges?

When you have all 4 badges, you can promote the fact that you are excelling at your Anti-Bullying work. Now it will be all about maintaining the high level of work in your school and passing your knowledge of how to be an excellent Anti-Bullying Ambassador to more students. Ask your staff member to talk to us about our Accreditation Programme which you might be interested in considering.
